

Coach To Be Named at Dickinson

Dickinson, Tex., Aug. 6. Dickinson's new football coach will be elected here Friday night at a meeting of the school board. E. N. Belcher, Dickinson school superintendent, announced tonight.

The board met tonight to decide a successor to Norman (Moose) Moller, who resigned recently, but failed to reach an agreement. Tommy Marshall, San Marcos star, is expected to take over the coaching reins.

Mr. Belcher said the Gators will play six-man football this fall, dropping out of District 29B 11-man circuit. Negotiations are being made now to attach the Gators with a six-man league.

Moller, resigned mentor, gave up the coaching job for a position at the Pan-American oil refinery, after four years as physical education instructor at Dickinson High. During the three years he coached football his teams met with moderate success.
